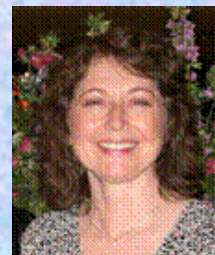
This is a free event however, donations are always welcomed.

April 12: Spring Theme

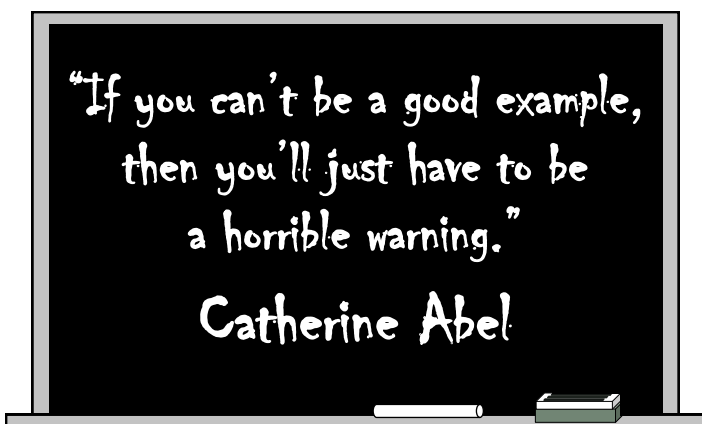
