Treasurer Jack Thompson informed us that before dues collected today, we had \$490 in the treasury. He collected 2008 Dues that are due this month.

Diann Anderson informed us that after missing last month's newsletter due to problems with her computer, she now has the problem partially rectified and should be able to resume the newsletter next month. Starting this month, all newsletters will be posted on our web site at www.cpsadc220.com.

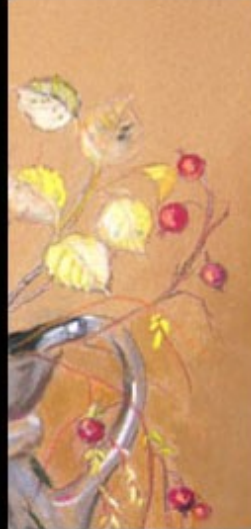
