This year there were 686 entries and 120 works chosen for the show. The Denver District Chapter Award for Excellence went to Solveig Nordwall for "Hokkaido Crane II". It is an elegant Japanese inspired work chosen by juror Ross Merrill, Chief of the Conservation Division of the National Gallery of Art.

I look forward to sharing things I learned in the workshop from Linda Lucas Hardy who received the highest award, the CIPPY, at this year's international show and the EXXPY Trophy at Explore This! 4 in Brea, California earlier this year. She is a very talented and humble artist and the workshop was great. She is the featured artist now at the national CPSA website (www.cpsa.org) and I encourage you all to take a look.

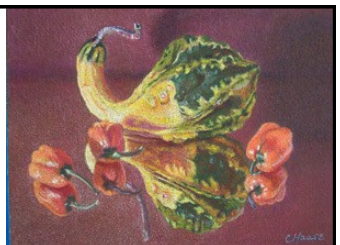

Featured Artist of the Month Michal Feder

Michal Feder arrived in the colored pencil world via the back door. Her father had promised to put her through art school after college but marrying at the age of 20 while still in college put an end to that.

In the mid 60's, she completed the "Famous Artists School" three year Commercial Art Home Study Program. She considers this by far the most valuable art training she has ever invested in. She has referred back repeatedly to written feedback and overlays of assignments. She had looked forward to a part time career in commercial art but an automobile accident in the late 60's involving a very sore back for many months, made that unrealistic.

Up until 2001, when she was 75, she experimented with various media - oils, acrylics, inks, and jewelry while raising three children, teaching American Government and International Relations at the high school level, and a variety of self management courses at the junior college level before co founding and running a management consulting and training firm - Mainstream Associates - focused on moving women into the mainstream of the working world during the 70's to early 90's.

Finally, after retiring from San Francisco to Boulder and casting about for a movable hobby she took up colored pencils. Ten books, a couple of local workshops and an

Elderhostel in Sedona, Arizona later, she fixed up the back of her garage and started to set aside some time to see where colored pencils would take her.

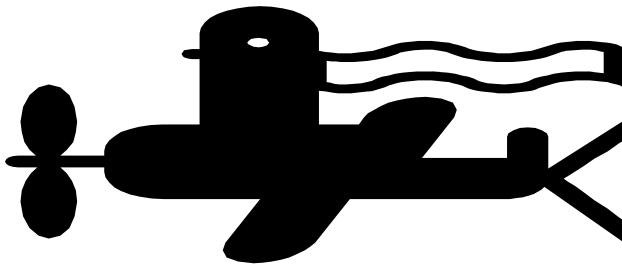

The next step in her evolution came when she discovered mylar and then Dr. PH Martin's Radiant Transparent inks. Abandoning more traditional subjects and techniques as too tedious and time consuming for her arthritic hands and an aging back, she has spent the last three years experimenting almost entirely with abstracts and abstract versions of recognizable subject matter. You can trace her development on her web site, www.michalsgallery.com. She admits to being seriously disinterested in diverting much time, effort and expense to marketing her art.

Says Michal, "Everybody laughs when they see me moving and talking in overdrive, but I believe I am in a race against time while I still have the energy, eye sight, and coordination to enjoy my art adventures and be productive."

If you like brilliant colors and intricate lines, shapes and textures, you may find yourself drawn to her current work. On the other hand, who knows what she will be doing next year!

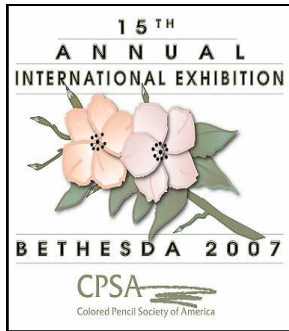

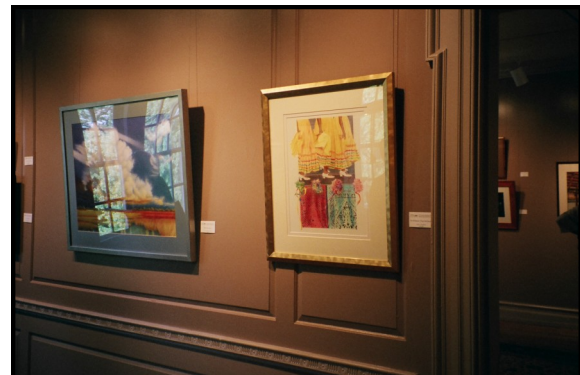
